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Saint Luke's Place Chief Executive Officer, Brian Swainson, was invited to facilitate a day-long professional development workshop "Measuring Up: Beyond the Financial Basics" hosted by the Ontario Association of Non-Profit Homes and Services for Seniors (OANHSS).

This one-day workshop held October 21<sup>st</sup> was attended by Administrators and other senior leaders in the Long-Term Care sector. Presenters included representatives from the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (Health System Funding Policy Branch and Health Quality Branch), University Academics, Health System leaders from Local Health Integration Networks, and Health Quality Ontario.

Presentations included information on Future Funding Reform in Long-Term Care, Resident Assessment Data Quality, Indicators and Quality, and Financial and Performance Management Accountability.

Mr. Swainson also co-presented a portion of the workshop with a focus on "Reporting to Your Board".
