On October 27th, Saint Luke's Place had a Grand Re-opening "Pool Party" event to celebrate the completion of the renovations to our Therapeutic Swimming Pool area. This project was partially funded through a one-time financial contribution from the Ontario Seniors' Secretariat (OSS) within our Elderly Persons Centre Program.

During the month of October, many health and safety enhancements and facility improvements were made to the Therapeutic Pool area, including: improvements to pool deck tiling and flooring, replacement of a safety hand rail, installation of new LED lighting for the whole pool area, renovations to the washrooms, shower and change rooms with new fittings and fixtures, and a great new paint job to brighten up the area. We are extremely grateful to the OSS for their one-time financial contribution towards this very worthwhile project to enhance the lives of the seniors in our community.

Our CEO, Brian Swainson, said a few introductory remarks to open the "Pool Party", and our celebration staff ambassadors (Alison and Pieter) showed their fun spirit by donning bathing suit costumes from the early 1900's to take tenants and residents on tours through the newly renovated pool area, showcasing all of the improvements and enhancements. Everyone who attended this event received a complimentary invitation to try one of our group aqua-fit programs, and nautical themed homemade cupcakes (thanks to Janice and Jen) were the treat of the day to complete our celebration.

We received many glowing comments from everyone who took a tour of our renovated Therapeutic Pool area, and a good time was had by all!
