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Saint Luke's Place Chief Executive Officer, Brian Swainson, has been asked to co-present an interactive workshop "**Financing Capital Development and Redevelopment Projects**" at the Ontario Association of Non-Profit Homes and Services for Seniors (OANHSS) Annual Meeting and Convention in April 2015.

Mr. Swainson is currently one of three OANHSS member representatives sitting on the **Stakeholder Advisory Committee** for the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care "Enhanced Long-Term Care Home Renewal Strategy". He was also recently appointed to the **Design Variance Advisory Committee** for the same Ministry Strategy.

- Discuss non-standard and innovative financing approaches to sustain housing in the not-for-profit sector; hear from member speakers about how they have handled a variety of financing issues.
