

NOTICE- COVID-19 VACCINE ROLL OUT FOR LONG TERM CARE RESIDENTS

January 11, 2021

We are pleased to announce that the Region of Waterloo Public Health Unit will be coming to Saint Luke's Place Wednesday January 13, 2021 to administer the first round of vaccine for COVID-19 to all our Long-Term Care Residents only.

By this time, all residents or substitute decision makers would have been contacted by one of the nursing leadership team to explain the process, the vaccine being administered, possible side effects and to gain consent.

The public health team coming to administer the vaccine will consist of registered nurses and a medical doctor to ensure the vaccine is properly stored, handled, and administered for the safety of all our residents.

This certainly is exciting news and brings us one step closer to flattening the curve of COVID 19 and protecting those we love.
